We are working towards shorter stays without threatening the safety of the patients. Over 95% of patients stayed less than a month at the hospital in 2010.

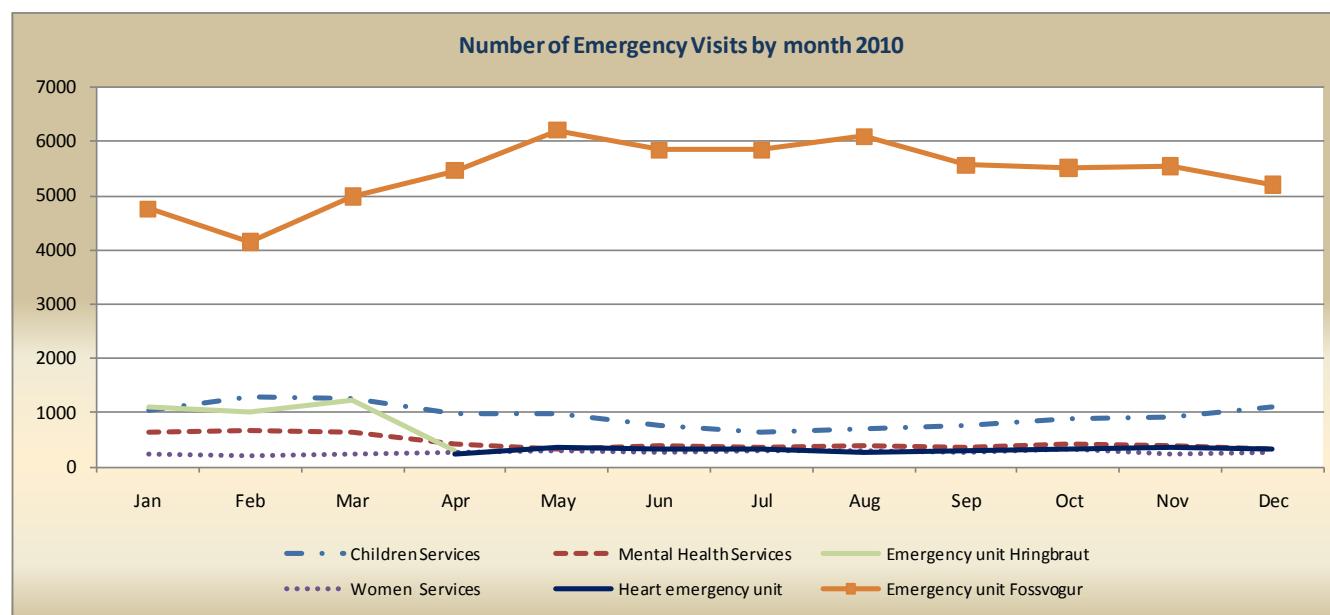
Inpatient days by division 2010

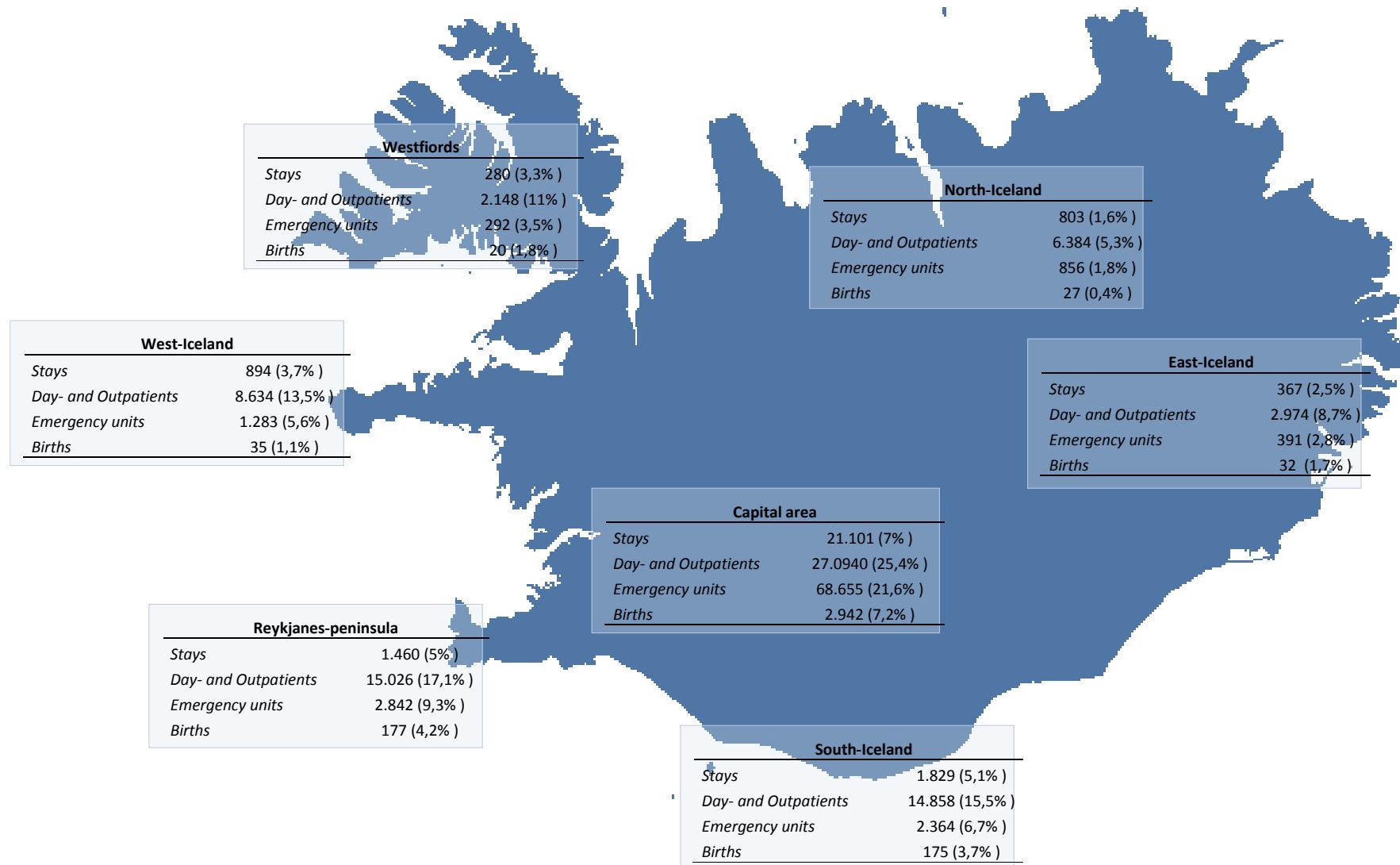

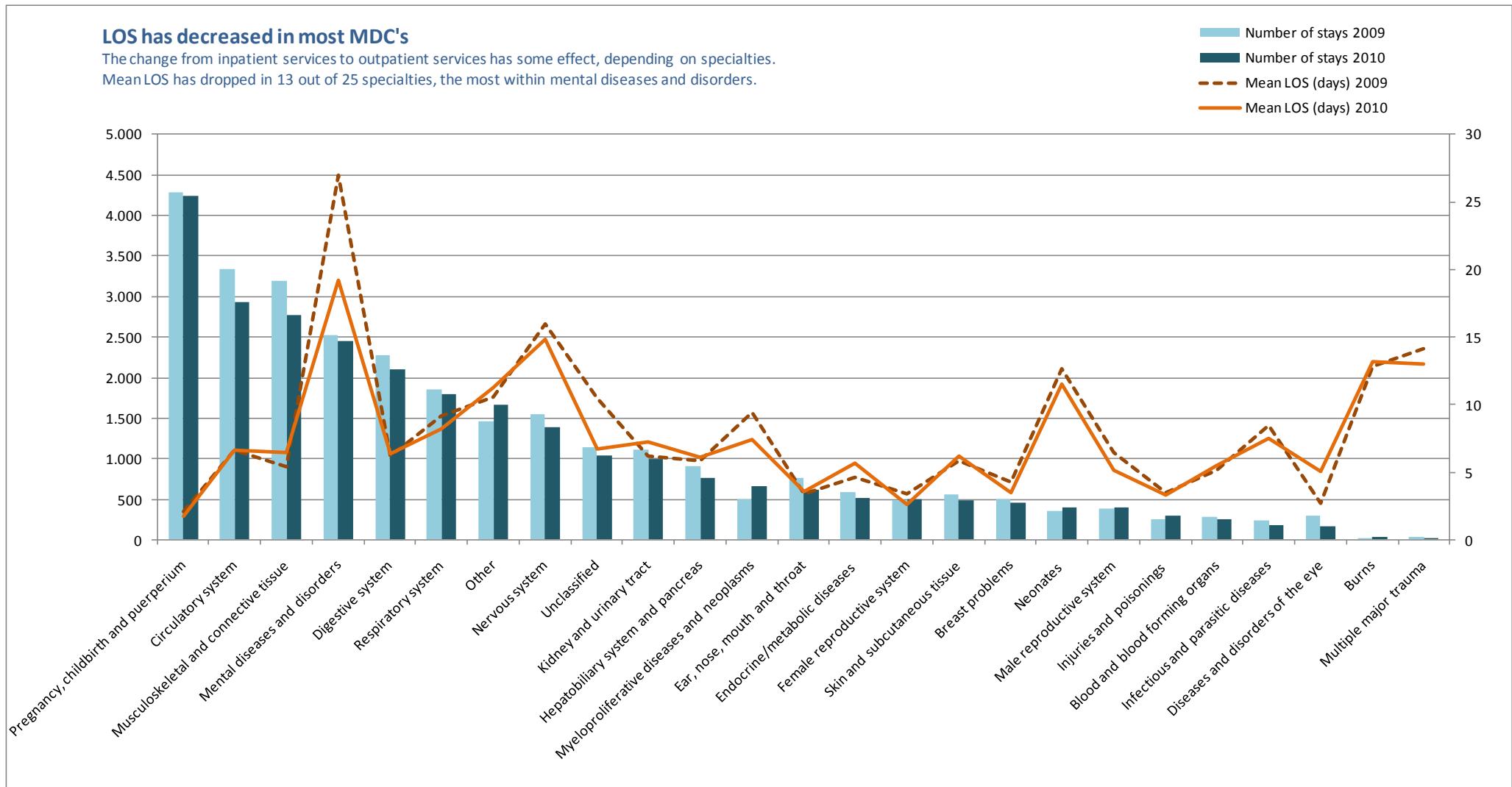
