
Iceland lays out roadmap to eliminating hepatitis C

WHO has set targets to eliminate hepatitis C virus (HCV) as a public health threat by 2030. In 2016, Iceland initiated TraP HepC: a nationwide HCV elimination programme. By adopting innovative strategies, it met WHO goals of diagnosing 90% of infections and treating 80% of diagnosed infections by 2030 within its first 3 years.
